

Basu supplemented this by the information that the SLS equipment of the Institute would be the seventh in the world and possibly first in Asia.


At the end of the discussions, the proposal was cleared by the Committee for a single centre study. Dr. R. Bhattacharya was told that it would be a good progress if 25 patients were operated on within the next six months.



The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.






